

Year Achievement Award Internal Policy

Description

A year achievement award will be presented to members having achieved 30 years as licensed and practicing members of CPNB. This certificate will be framed and presented to the member, along with a pin (i.e. 30 year pin), at the AGM.

Qualifications

Members having achieved 30 years as a member of CPNB with the “Licensed” status will qualify for the award. The 30 years does not need to be continuous. Members who have had to cancel their membership or change to non-practicing or non-practicing retired for any reason will still qualify. The years they were not active or practicing members will not count towards their 30 years.

Restrictions

Awards will only be given to members in good standing (i.e. who have paid their membership dues) and that have had no disciplinary actions against them during their entire tenure with CPNB.

Procedure

CPNB staff will advise the members and send them a special invitation to attend the AGM so they can receive their award and be recognized by their peers. If the member is unable to attend the AGM, the framed certificate and pin will be mailed to them along with a letter from the President and Registrar of CPNB.

A special mention will also be made at the AGM to acknowledge members who have recently retired to congratulate them on their retirement, regardless of whether they have obtained the 30 year achievement award.

N.B. This policy will not be retroactive and will only begin at the 2019 AGM.
